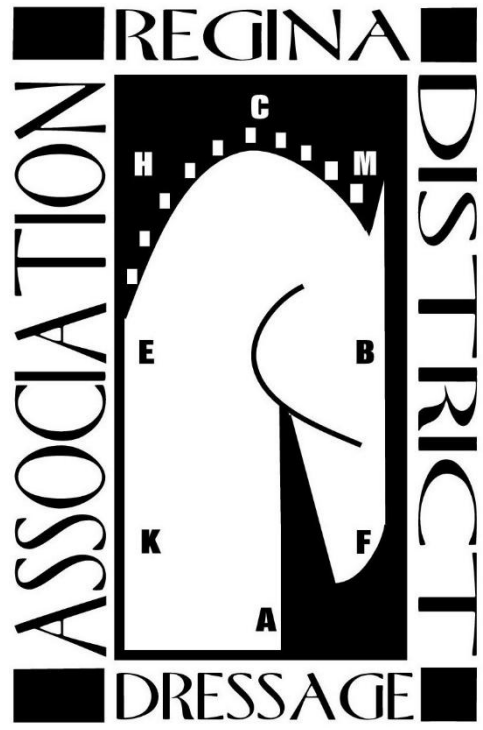


**Regina District Dressage Association (RDDA) Presents:

## **X-Halt-Salute Virtual Dressage Show**

Due to existing COVID concerns and restrictions, the ability to organize and host in-person shows is temporarily on pause. In its place, the RDDA is providing a video submission show. The dates of the show during which you can submit your recorded test will be over a two-week window from May 21 - June 4, 2021. Our judge is Kim Vos who is an EC Medium Level judge.

To participate, riders will record their test(s) and then upload them to YouTube. A completed registration form will be submitted to the RDDA along with a fee of \$25 per test that is submitted for judging. RDDA members will receive a \$5 discount on each test they submit and will also be eligible for prizes. Prize categories will include: High Score Open/Junior, High Score Western Dressage Open/Junior, and best Turn out. To be entered for the best turnout prize, please submit a photo of you and your horse from the day you recorded your test.

Riders will have the choice of which tests they would like to ride, and how many they would like to submit for judging. Tests to be used are EC for classical dressage and WSDAC for Western Dressage.

### Guidelines and Rules

- Participants will be required to hold an active SHF membership.
- Riders are encouraged to compete at their level of capability and should refer to the test 'purpose' located at the top of the test for reference.
- All riders are required to wear protective headwear as well as appropriate footwear/boots.

- Show attire is not required, but horses, tack and turnout should be clean and tidy. Braiding is encouraged, but not required.
- Protective leg wraps/boots for horses are permitted to be worn.
- Tests must be recorded in an enclosed arena or ring with a minimum 20m x 40m for tests up to and including First Level, and 20m x 60 for tests Second Level and beyond. - The camera must be placed at "C" (far end of ring/arena), approximately 5 m (16.5 feet) back and between 1.5m-2.5m (5 feet -8 feet) high. If the zoom feature is used- the horse may be no larger than 1/4 of the screen. Please use landscape mode, and it is recommended that a tripod is used for stability. The recording should start approximately 5 seconds before the class or individual rider enters the arena. In an indoor arena, the rider may already be in the arena, and the recording will start 5 seconds before judging of the test begins. The recording should finish approximately 5 seconds after the test ends or after the final salute at the end of an individual test.

- Make sure that a well-lighted arena is used. Please preview your video submission to ensure that it is clear before submitting your entry.

### Test Submission

- Tests will be submitted through YouTube. Once you have recorded your test, upload the file to YouTube. It is recommended that the title of the video be the name of the test being ridden as well as the name of the horse. Please be aware that posting videos on YouTube without security settings will allow outside individuals to view your video. It is highly recommended that users set the YouTube security setting to “Unlisted” (Only those who have been provided the link, can view the video).

Payment can be e-transferred to the same email. **Password: Videoshow**. Cost is \$25.00 per test or \$20.00 per test for RDDA members and can be sent as a lump sum per rider if there is more than one test. Tests will not be judged unless payment is received.
